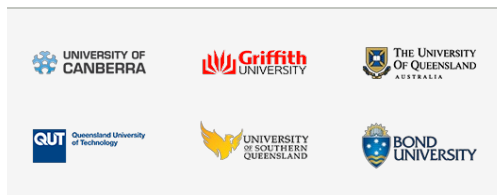
University pathways
