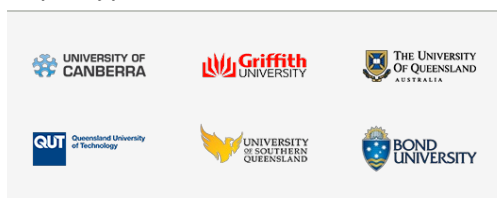
University pathways
