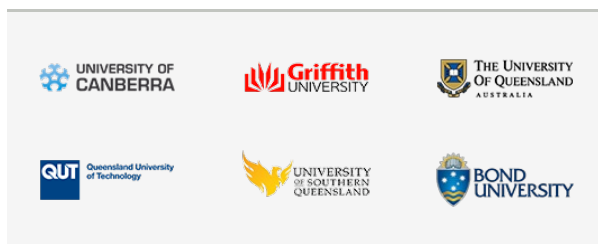
University pathways
