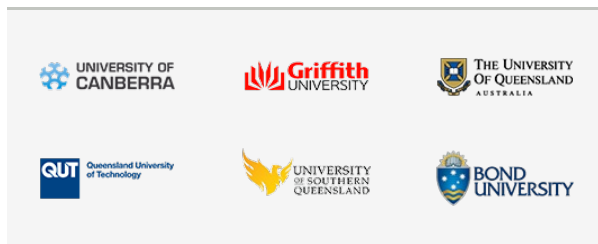
University pathways
