The Queensland Department of Education and Training recognises this qualification in its salary structure for teacher aides. Formal qualifications may lead to additional salary increments.

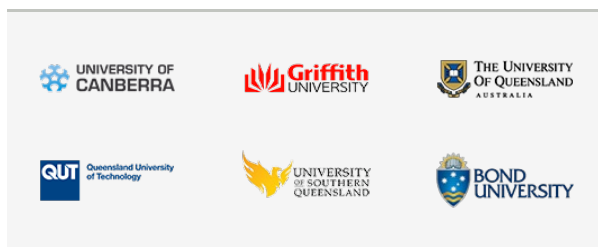
University pathways
