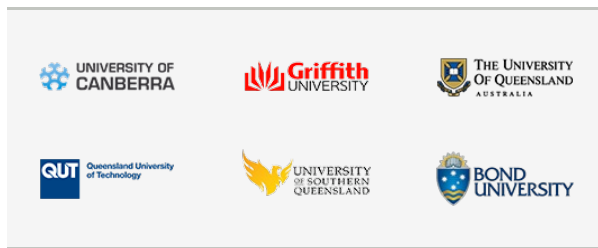
University pathways
