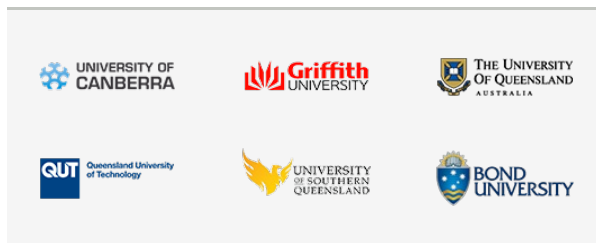
### University pathways
