PROGRAM OVERVIEW

London is at the epicentre of the European event scene attracting international events and hosting the recent London 2012 Olympic Games. The main host venue for the Study Tour, ExCeL London is Europe's premier event centre was an Olympic venue hosting 13 Olympic and Paralympic sports. The study tour aims to provide students with an international sports and events experience, providing site tours with briefings on the operations of major sports and event stadiums and master-classes from leading event and sports managers. The programme supports students in developing a breadth of understanding of the key skills required to stage high profile special events and sports competitions. The Event School London partners with ExCeL London for MasterClass speaker expertise in events and venue management and the University of East London for Elite Sports Performance Development.

Both the Events and Sports cohorts will have the opportunity to participate in the following site visits: Wembley Sports Stadium; Wimbledon, The O2 Concert and Sports Arena, The Crystal Eco-venue and iconic Olympic Park venues.
