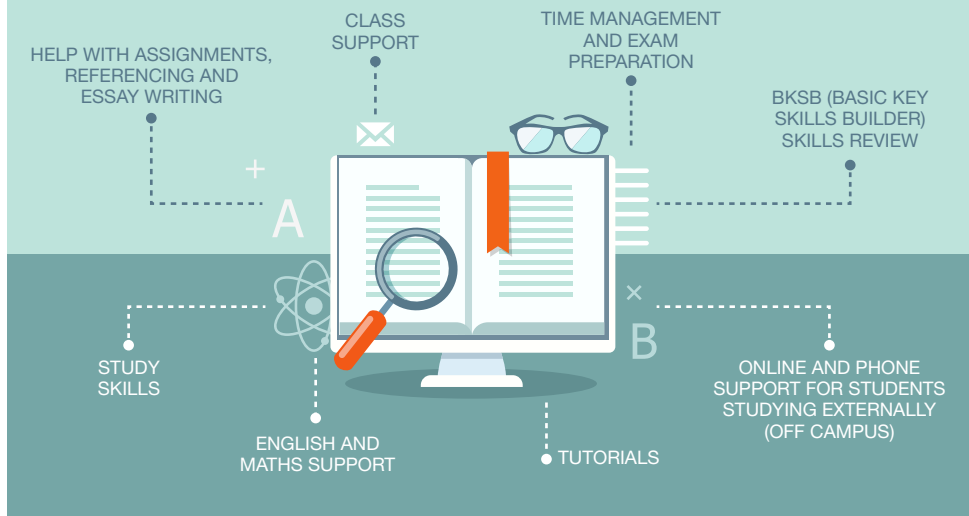

## LEARNING SKILLS CENTRE



The **Learning Skills Centre** is for students enrolled in certificate and diploma programs, and who need extra help with their course.

The teachers at the **Learning Skills Centre** have experience in helping students from different educational backgrounds. At the **Learning Skills Centre**, there's always someone to help, no matter who you are or where you've come from.

The teachers will take the time to work with you to understand your needs, test your confidence with skills you need for your course, and make sure training is paced at a level that works for you. The teachers can also create an individual learning plan to provide targeted support.

Teachers provide help across a broad range of topics, from basic to complex. Some students benefit from improving their spelling, maths and reading comprehension. Others seek particular skills to meet assessment requirements, research analysis or assignment writing, for example. The **Learning Skills Centre** works on a drop-in basis - no appointments required. It's there as a safety net when an urgent study issue arises.

All new TAFE Queensland Brisbane students must complete the **bksb** (basic key skills builder) analysis before starting any training.

**bksb** is an easy-to-use, online assessment tool that gives an overview of your learning strengths and determines your English and maths levels, against the Australian Core Skills Framework (ACSF).

This assessment tool helps us to identify how we can best support you through your chosen course. An individual learning plan is then generated and you gain access to a range of interactive learning resources and support tutorials.

All TAFE Queensland Brisbane students have free access to the online afterhours support service YourTutor. Through YourTutor, you can chat online to expert tutors who can help you with your studies.

The tutors can help with your writing, research, referencing. They can even help with specific subject questions in areas including maths, chemistry, biology, physics, statistics, microeconomics, macroeconomics, marketing, and accounting.

**YourTutor** is available between the hours of 3pm and midnight, Sunday - Friday. This service is accessed from Connect, my.TAFE or through the TAFE Queensland Brisbane library websites.
