Frequently Asked Questions - Students

01

Do I need to have my TAFE Queensland Brisbane Student ID to print?

You need to have the RFID Card you associated your MyPrint Account with. This can be your TAFE Student ID, your GoCard or even a Building Access Card

Does my course provide me with a printing allotment?

TAFE students enrolled in eligible courses are provided with a printing allotment at the start of their course which they can utilise on printers throughout the TAFE Queensland Brisbane region. Please ask your teacher to see if your course is eligible. The complimentary printing allotment is not refundable, its not transferable to other accounts and expires when no longer enrolled in the eligible course.

How do I add credit to my card?

Can I get a refund?

This is a prepaid service and credit that you add to your account cannot be refunded to you.

Can I use my own paper?

No. Only paper provided may be used in TAFE Printers.

What if I print alot?

There are paper saving options you can try to introduce -

- Printing duplex (double sided)
- Reading and editing documents online
- Proofreading documents
- Talk with your teacher about managing class materials
- Printing only the information you want
- Download documents to a USB stick
